The 2012 Alberta Winter Games is the premier multi-sport event in the Province of Alberta. These Games are set to take place on February 9-12, 2012 in the Spruce Grove / Parkland County / Stony Plain region, where the sport of Judo will feature the top athletes born in the years between 1996 and 2000 who have obtained their first belt (yellow belt) by the December selection tournament. In an effort to provide training and competitive opportunities for all eligible athletes, please see the schedule below:

Training Camps

- * Athletes are required to attend the camp for their respective zone.
- * Training Camps will be planned and run by the Zone Coaches for their respective camp.

Zones 1, 2, 3 & 4

October 15 & 16, 2011 – Lethbridge, Lethbridge Judo Club Dojo

November 12, 2011 – Airdrie, Plainsman Arena

Zones 5, 6, 7 & 8

October 15 & 16, 2011 – Fort Saskatchewan, Dow Centre

November 19, 2011 – Fort Saskatchewan, Dow Centre

Fight Offs

All Fight Offs for the Alberta Winter Games will take place on December 10, 2011.

Zones 1, 2, 3 & 4: Lethbridge, Lethbridge Judo Club Dojo

Zones 5, 6, 7 & 8: Fort Saskatchewan, Dow Centre

Judo Alberta will have some funding available to help offset the cost of accommodations and expenses to travel, though this will not be available until March 2012.
