RULES: Please note the following rules for the **U9, U11 & U13:**

- Grip must be in the front of the judogi (traditional sleeve and lapel) unless attempting a hip technique.
- The following techniques will not be allowed in the U9, U11 and U13 divisions--kubinage and similar throws, tani otoshi, all drop down techniques which start on one or two knees (ie. drop seoinage), makikomi waza.
- Sutemi waza is prohibited for U9 & U11 BUT allowed in U13.
- Shime-waza and kansetsu waza is not permitted in U15 and younger.
- There will be no "Golden Score" for U15 and younger categories.
- Modified medical rules for U17 and younger; only 2 medical examinations allowed to continue competing; blood will be dealt with in the usual manner
- Arm locks are not permitted in U17 and younger
- The minimum rest period between matches shall be 5 minutes.
- Blue judogi is optional, but recommended. Last name called must wear a blue judogi.
- Judo Canada regulations as of the tournament date to be enforced.
- Females must wear a plain white outfit under their judogi
- U9 divisions may combine genders
- U9 & U11 divisions may combine weight divisions to a limit of 1 division higher.

FORMAT:

U9 & U11– In accordance with Judo Canada's Long Term Athlete Development Plan (LTADP), these divisions will be skill based. Competitors will be grouped by weight and athletes will participate in a number of randori bouts. During these bouts an ippon will not end the match. Contestants will compete for 2 minutes running time. Only in the case where one athlete dominates by 3 consecutive ippons, injury, or grave infraction of the rules will the match be suspended. One judge will officiate, but will not call conventional scores, as competitors will be allowed to fight as in randori. The judge will control the flow of the match calling matte when appropriate and advising competitors of prohibited acts. Ne waza will continue as long as there is progress. When osae waza is executed, it will be allowed until there is no apparent advance in escape by uke, at which time the judge will announce 'matte' and resume in tachi waza randori. A grouping of 2-5 athletes and a round robin draw format will be used.

Technical ability, willingness to compete and sportsmanship will evaluate the match. The technical assessment will not only include throw appreciation, but also osae waza, effective transition from tachi waza to ne waza, renraku waza, ability to destabilize and throw in different directions, utilization of different techniques, utilization of hando no kuzushi, as well as an evaluation of posture.

Double knockout for 6 competitors or more. Round robin will apply for 5 or fewer competitors. Must be a paid up member of Judo Alberta, or other affiliated province or state judo organization, and be able to prove membership and age.

Blue judogi is mandatory for all competitors in Senior Men Brown/Black. This will be strictly enforced.

Grand Championships

This event is held only at the Provincial Championships. For men, the Grand Championship is for Ikkyu and Yudansha only. For women, the Grand Championship is for ranks of gokyu and up. Each contestant in the Grand Championship must be 18 years of age or older. If the winner of a particular weight division is under the age of 18 years, there will be no contestant in that weight division.

Some concern has been expressed over the safety factor in having individuals competing against each other whose weights vary widely. The Technical Committee is also aware that for at least 85 years of its 110-year history, judo was without weight divisions. To preserve the traditions and to take into account the safety of the contestants, the Committee has adopted a procedure whereby men in the -60, -66 and -73 weights compete as a group; the -81, -90, -100 and +100 men compete as a group. Then, the two group winners compete for the title of "Grand Champion". The matches are to be straight elimination.

Where a female Grand Championship is to be held, the winners of the -48, -52 and -57 kg categories will fight as a group; the winners of the -63, -70, -78, and +78 kg categories will fight as a group. The two group winners will then fight for the title of "Grand Champion". The matches are to be straight elimination.
