



CLUB SPONSORSHIP BY VOTING MEMBERS

PURPOSE:

To provide guidelines to voting members of the Association who sponsor clubs of which they are not personally a member.

POLICY:

Judo Alberta recognizes that there may be clubs which do not have an instructor who is a holder of a black belt recognized by Judo Canada. The By-Laws of the Association specify that such clubs must be sponsored by a voting member of the Association (Article IX, Section 6). When agreeing to sponsor such a club, voting members should be aware of what the position entails. The following is intended as a guide and is not to be considered exhaustive of the requirements.

The voting member sponsor is responsible:

1. To be sure that the sport of Kodokan Judo is taught in the correct manner.
2. To be sure that the principles of the NCCP are followed
3. To visit the club regularly and observe the training sessions.
4. To be present for all grading examinations.
5. To assist the club instructor as requested.
6. To ensure they meet the requirements of Policy # 6-01.
