Selection Criteria and Guidelines for Canada Winter Games

Purpose

This policy will be used to select a Provincial Team to attend the Canada Winter Games for Team Alberta.

Policy:

I. Point System & Selection Procedure

1. The provincial team list is based on points accumulated per weight class as per the Canada Winter Games technical package.
2. The selection tournaments for the Games will be in the spring of 2018, the 2018 Open Nationals (Spring) and in the fall of 2018 that are hosted in Year 4 of the Games. (Competitions, location, & date TBD)
3. The two Alberta Provincial tournaments will run Games age and weight divisions closed to Alberta athletes only. The Open Nationals will take into account the results of U16 and U18 Open Nationals. Athletes cannot accumulate points in both the U16 and U18 weight division at the 2018 Open Nationals. The best result of the athlete will count towards the selection points.
4. Athletes need to have national level or international competitive experience prior to the final selection. To be nominated to the team athletes needed to compete in 1 of 2 first selection events.

*Athletes cannot accumulate points in both the SR, U21, U18 and U16 weight divisions at the 2018 Open Nationals. The best result of the athlete will count towards the selection points.

The number one seed will be determined following the 2018 Open Nationals competition for each weight division. The number one seed in each weight division will be invited to participate in the 2018 Canada Winter Games summer preparation program. (Summer 2018)

The next two top point gainers out of all the weight division (2 Male and 2 Female) that are not the number one seed in the weight division will be invited to be part of the 2018 Canada Winter Games summer preparation program. Additional Provincial team members will be welcome to join the program on a self-funded bases.

2018 Fall Final Selection Competition

If the number one seed wins the fall Canada Winter Games selection competition they will be nominated to represent team Alberta at the 2019 Canada Winter Games. If the number one seed of the weight division loses in the selection competition they will be given a 1 match fight off. The winner of this match will represent Alberta at the 2019 Canada Winter Games

Athletes that change weight division for the final selection competition will have their points cut by 50% to determine their seeding.

II. Judo Alberta Requirements

1. Athlete must have been a resident of Alberta for six months.
2. Athlete must present proof of age when required.
3. Athlete must be a paid up member in good standing with Judo Alberta and Judo Canada.
4. The athlete must comply with all Judo Canada restrictions at the time of the final selection tournament, to be included in the Provincial Team list.

III. Appeal Procedure

There will be no appeals allowed for on-mat contention. An appeal will be allowed only if it is a question of eligibility of a competitor and must be done before the first match of the athlete in question. The appeal must be in writing and submitted to the sport coordinator or designate within 1 hour of the appeal. An appeal committee will be made up of the provincial head coach, the sport coordinator, and a technical committee chair, or a designate of each position. A decision on the appeal must be made within 1 hour of the initial appeal. The decision will be made in writing to all parties involved and will be binding.

V. Funding

Judo Alberta may provide funding to various competitions for Alberta Canada Winter Games eligible athletes, budget permitting.
